

# The RITM is recruiting an Assistant Professor in Economics and is organizing an "Open House Day" on Friday, March 21!

The RITM (Research Center in Economics and Management at Université Paris-Saclay) is recruiting an Assistant Professor in Economics (05 MCF). To get to know each other and discover the campus, candidates are invited to meet with RITM members on **Friday, March 21**, at the Jean Monnet Faculty of Law, Economics, and Management in Sceaux (access map).

Interested candidates can express their interest by sending a CV and a job market paper to Jean-Noël Senne (<u>jean-noel.senne@universite-paris-saclay.fr</u>) by <u>March 2 (inclusive</u>).

The format and schedule of these meetings will be specified later, depending on the number of candidates.

## **General information**

### Research

The person recruited will conduct research at <u>RITM</u>, the <u>Research Center in Economics and Management of the University of Paris-Saclay</u>. We recruit in applied economics in any field covered by the research center: Regional and urban economics, economic policy, economics of innovation, digital economy, development and international economics, environmental economics...

This recruitment is part of a strategy deployed over the last few years to strengthen scientific production on RITM's main topics. It also aims to contribute to the scientific and societal challenges identified by the Graduate School in Economics and Management of the University of Paris-Saclay, and to develop research synergies between the university's partners, in particular ENS Paris-Saclay, and the University of Evry).

We want to draw the candidates' attention to the total involvement in research expected by the econ department:

- A substantial contribution in terms of high-level publications;
- An active participation in seminars and collective projects;
- An appetite for the valorization of research and its dissemination to audiences other than academics;
- Experience in research animation (participation in national or international research projects) and a willingness to apply for ambitious funding programs (ANR, ERC, educational innovation projects...) would be very much appreciated, as well as an ability to engage in scientific dialogue with other disciplines.

We also expect the recruited person to participate actively in the life of the Faculty and/or the University and their governance.

## **Teaching and Administrative Responsibilities**

Teaching is one of the core missions of the University. The person recruited will be expected to teach at the bachelor's and/or Master's level, in areas that may not necessarily align with their research specialties. They may be required to teach undergraduate courses such as "Money and Finance," "Market Finance," "International Trade," or "Introduction to Economics." Proficiency in French is essential, and the ability to teach in English is an asset.

Université Paris-Saclay offers all newly recruited Assistant Professors a 20% teaching reduction (42 hours) for the first 2 years. The candidate will gradually take on administrative tasks related to the management of teaching and research.

### Location

Université Paris-Saclay has several campuses located in the south of Paris, along the RER B line. The Department of Economics and RITM are based at the Sceaux campus (RER Robinson). Classes are held either at the Sceaux campus, the Vallée campus in Orsay (RER Orsay or Bures-sur-Yvette), or at ENS Paris-Saclay for particular master's programs (RER Le Guichet).
